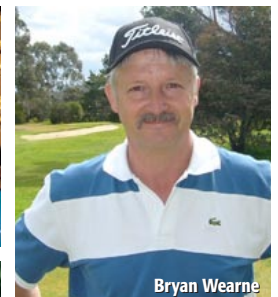

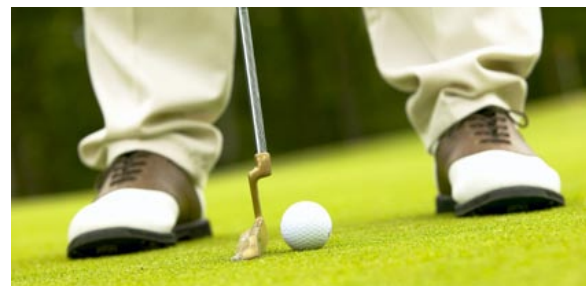

THE COURSES

Norman Course: The Great White Shark, has won more than 90 career titles including 18 PGA Tour Victories and 2 British Opens. Norman is also a renowned course designer and his course at Mission Hills features dramatic and abundant deep bunkering surrounded by thick forest. It is expected to be one of the toughest in Asia.

Annika Course: Former world number one Annika Sorenstam has won 72 official LPGA tournaments, including ten majors and 18 others internationally. She is the only female golfer to have shot a 59 in competition. Annika's first course showcases her best talent: precision.

Leadbetter Course: David Leadbetter is widely known as one of the world's leading golf instructors. Leadbetter designed the course with the intention of challenging the golfer to use every club in their golf bag when playing the course.

Olazabal Course: Jose Maria Olazabal is a two-time US Masters champion. Olazabal's first course in China reflects his reputation as one of the best bunker players on tour. With an astounding 160 bunkers, the Olazabal Course is the longest at Mission Hills at 7,400 yards.

Duval Course: David Duval has won a total of 13 PGA Tour titles and his Course at Mission Hills features a traditional design with numerous water hazards, deep ground cover and a mixture of long, short and double dogleg holes, providing a unique challenge to any golfer.

Stadium Course: The outstanding shot-making skill of 3-time US Open and 3-time British Open winner Nick Faldo is evident on the challenging course design of his stunning course. This course features one of the world's most spectacular island greens on the signature 16th hole.

World Cup Course by Jack Nicklaus: Regarded as the greatest player of the 20th century, Jack Nicklaus has won more than 70 PGA Tour titles, including 6 Masters, 4 US Opens, 3 British Opens and 5 PGA Championships. As a renowned golf course designer, many of his courses are consistently ranked in the Top 100 course rankings around the world. The course features numerous bunkers and water hazards and is considered one of the best tournament courses in Asia.

Els Course: Ernie Els, the "Big Easy," has had 60 professional wins including the US and British Opens. This is his first course in Asia. Diverse terrains and elevations feature: part of the course meanders through a pristine river basin, and the rest is situated in the foothills.

Vijay Course: Vijay Singh has won 34 PGA Tour titles, including the 2000 US Masters, and 1998 and 2004 PGA Championships. The Vijay Course features stunning and distinctive use of long sandy waste bunkers, and is one of the most impressive courses in the region.

Ozaki Course: Jumbo Ozaki has dominated Japanese golf for the past three decades and remains one of the most famous Asian faces in the world of professional golf. Ozaki has created one of the most scenic courses where many of the holes are played through dramatic canyons of thick forest. The course's sweeping sculptured bunkering and water features evoke a Zen-like, calming atmosphere.

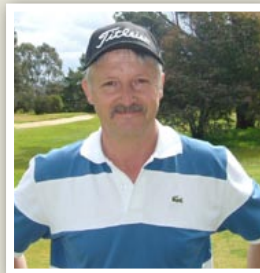
